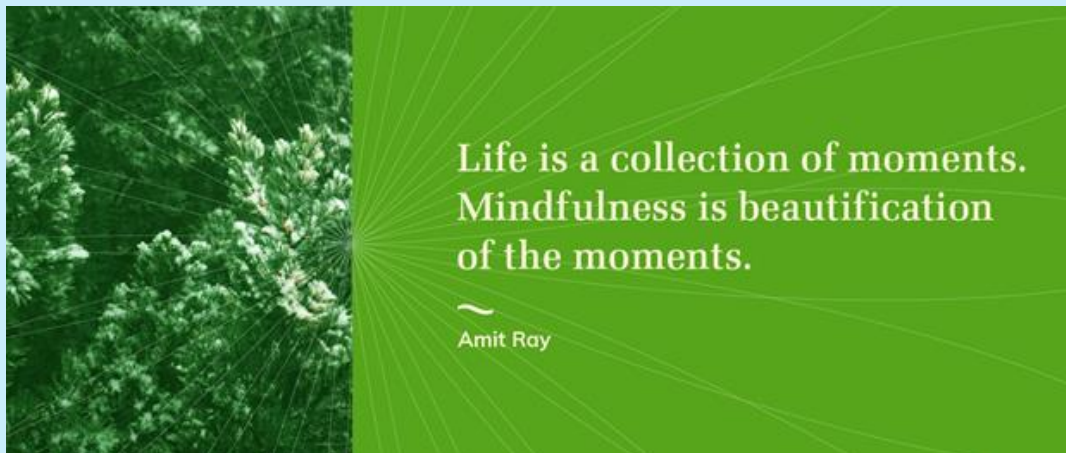

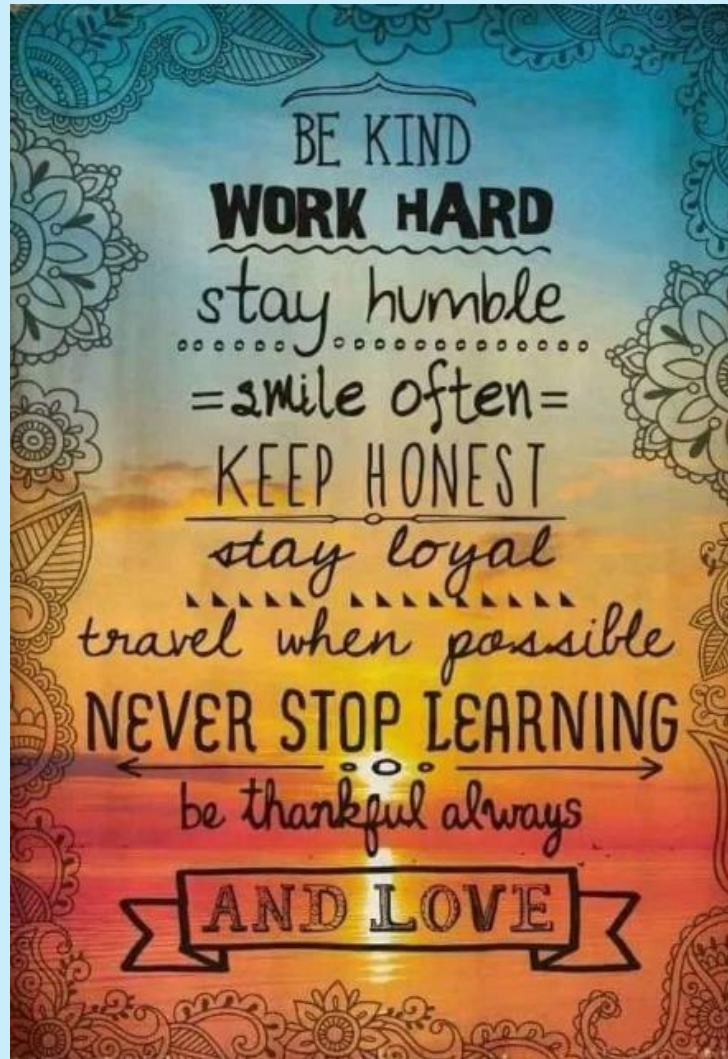
About Rev. Anita

Ageism
Mind, Body, and Spirit Connection - June, 2024

What is “ageism” and what is the effect it can have on our relationships? According to Wikipedia, “ageism is a bias against, discrimination towards or bullying of individuals and groups based on their age, younger or older. The term was coined in 1969 by Robert Neil Butler to describe discrimination against the elderly, patterned on the terminology of sexism and racism.” Ageism can be seen as stereotypes, prejudice, or discrimination against (but also in favor of) people because of their chronological age.

We have all noted prejudice or discrimination on the grounds of a person’s age. Sometimes it is against young people, but often this systematic stereotyping and discrimination is against older adults. Ageism can be expressed at three different levels: micro-level (individual), meso-level (social networks), and macro-level (institutional and cultural). We are all guilty of ageism at a personal, institutional, intentional (explicit), or unintentional (unconscious/implicit) level.

Ageism continues to be an increasing problem in recruitment for many job opportunities. Ageism is most common in physical or manual industries where jobs require physical labor, such as construction, manufacturing, and shipping. Many employers have a high age bias due to employers assuming older workers are not physically capable of performing these roles effectively. There are many young people who can’t do the job. Some examples of explicit ageism are: refusing to hire people over or under a certain age, asking for someone’s age at a job interview, enacting policies that unfairly privilege one age group over another, viewing older people as out of touch, less productive, or stuck in their ways.

Age harassment can include age-based jokes or comments, offensive cartoons, symbols, or gestures, and other verbal and physical conduct based on an individual’s age. We remember being told we were too young to do something and now I hear people say I am too old. LOL

The most frequent form of ageism is disrespect for older adults, especially in our health care system. Implicit ageist behaviors may include a lack of patience and respect when interacting with older people, exclusion from family and medical decision-making, and the use of condescending speech known as “elderspeak.” Explicit ageism becomes evident when older populations face discrimination by younger and older ones. Some examples that appear in personal relationships include: treating family members as though they are invisible, unintelligent, or expendable based on their age, making ageism jokes that imply someone is less valuable or less worthy of respect because of their age. Sometimes people do this with each other, as well, no matter what their own age is at the time.

We all hear and speak examples of ageist comments. Ageism affects everyone as we stereotype (how we think, speak, feel, and act toward others and oneself based on age). Never tell me I am too old to go dancing, drive long distances, walk a couple miles, bike 8-10 miles in an hour or 20 miles in two hours, garden, mow my own lawn, become computer savvy, or be a traveler! Those who know me, will testify that I am “forever young at heart!” How do you identify yourself?

Ahimsa /uh · him' · suh/

A religious principle of non-violence and respect for all life. Ahimsa is Sanskrit for avoidance of himsa, or injury. It is interpreted most often as meaning peace and reverence toward all sentient beings. Ahimsa is the core of Hinduism, Jainism, and Buddhism. Its first mention in Indian philosophy is found in the Hindu scriptures called the Upanishads, the oldest dating about 800 BC. Those who practice Ahimsa are often vegetarians or vegans.

Wrinkle the Duck has run FOUR marathons. He has run the New York City Marathon three times (2021, 2022, 2023) as well as the 2021 Long Island Marathon!

Just like all the great runners, Wrinkle fuels up, runs, hydrates (she watered up at least 10 times), and gets a medal at the end!

Her adoptive parents, Justin Wood and Joyce Kung of the Justin Wood Circus Variety Show, were training her for parading.

"She has very good endurance in walking and running," Kung said. "We just figured out a good way to display it."

Wrinkle wears custom shoes made from a soft, waterproof material, to protect her little duck feet.

We tried to determine how far Wrinkle ran during the races; in 2021, it was estimated that she ran about a half-mile with stops. Footage from this year's race shows her running during the day and after the sun went down at the race's iconic finish line in Central Park. FACTOID


Ketchup was sold in the 1830s as medicine. In 1834, it was sold as a cure for an upset stomach by an Ohio physician named John Cook. It wasn't popularized as a condiment until the late 19th century.



Few flavors complement each other like lemon and lime, with many a refreshing treat combining both for maximum effect. The two citrus fruits have some key differences, however, including the fact that limes sink while lemons float. You may have noticed this if you've ever put lime and lemon slices in a glass of water or cocktail, and the reason is simple: Objects only float if they're less dense than the liquid they're placed in, and while both limes and lemons have densities close to that of water, limes are denser than their yellow counterparts. That remains true whether the lemon or lime in question is whole, peeled, or sliced — a lemon will always float, and a lime will always sink.

In 1944, working on a commission from the War Advertising Council and the U.S. Forest Service, Saturday Evening Post artist Albert Staehle and writer Harold Rosenberg crafted the reassuring, safety-conscious Smokey Bear, now the face of the country's longest-running public service campaign, where he frequently shares his famous slogan: "Only you can prevent wildfires." In 1950, a 5-pound black bear cub rescued from a New Mexico wildfire by Taos Pueblo firefighters was christened "Smokey Bear" as a living homage to the popular protective figure.


This bear spent the rest of his life at the National Zoo in Washington, D.C. There, he, his successor — Smokey II — and their alter ego received up to 13,000 letters, drawings, Christmas cards, and honey shipments each week. To help sort these deliveries, the bears were given their own Washington, D.C., ZIP code: 20252. From around 2007 to 2014, the ZIP code was decommissioned, but it was revived for the mascot's 70th anniversary. The original bear also has his own Instagram and Twitter accounts, where he shares fire prevention tips with the hashtag #OnlyYou — now a more vital message than ever.

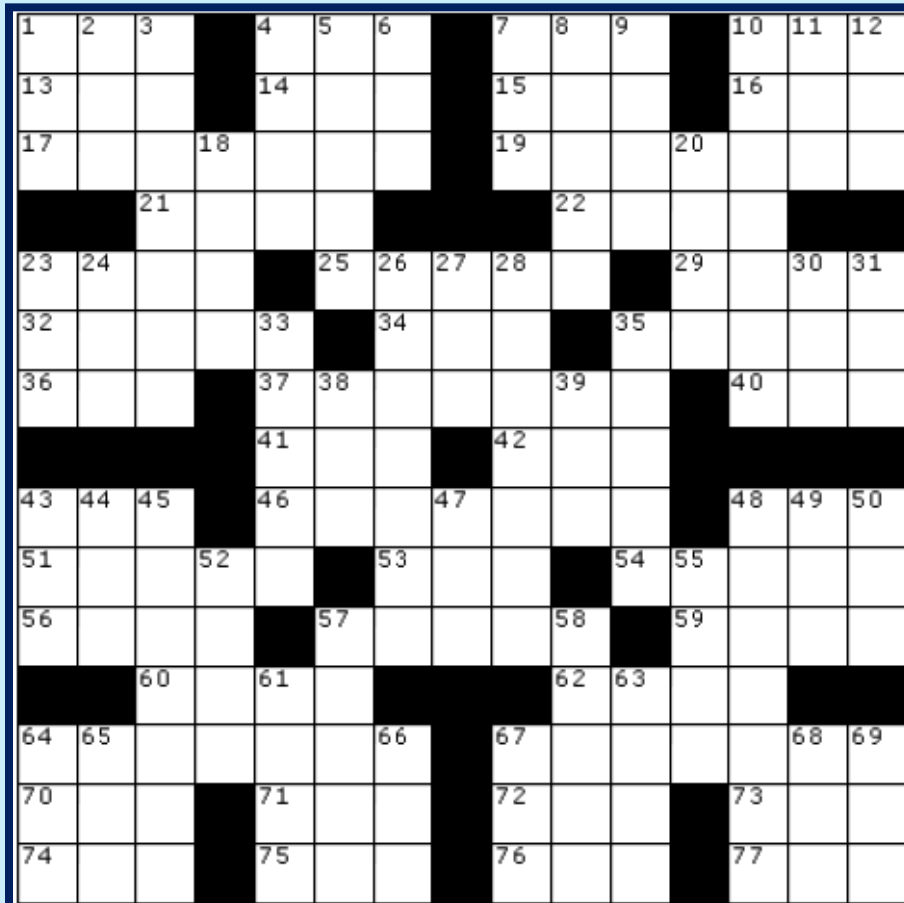
Simple candle alarm clock design from Ancient Rome. It has two snoozes apparently.

Once again, the man appeared, this time muttering, "You really blew it. You didn't have a thing to say, pastor."

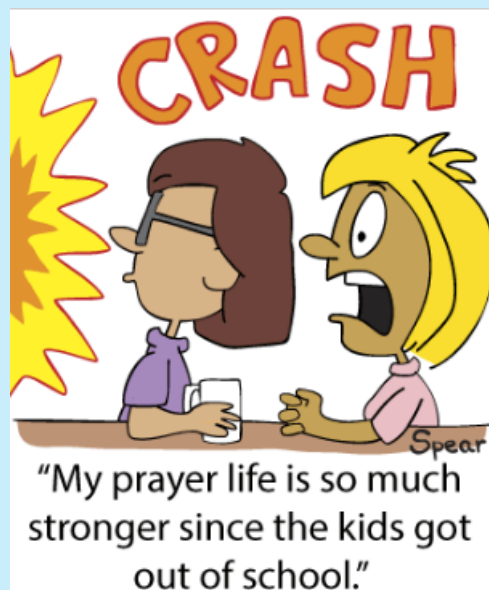
Finally, the minister could stand it no longer. He went to one of the deacons and inquired about the man.

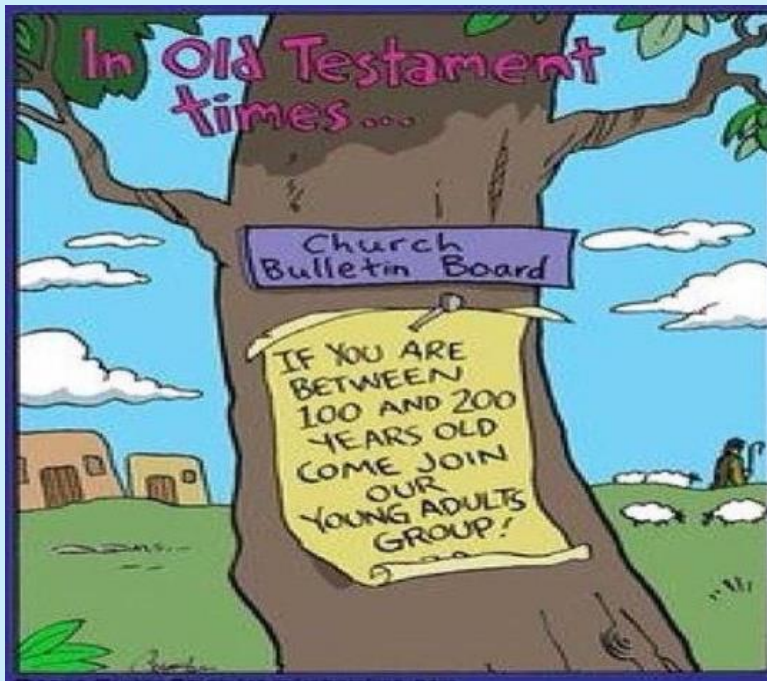
"Oh, don't let that guy bother you," said the deacon. "He's a little slow. All he does is go around repeating whatever he hears other people saying."

- On Sunday Mrs. Ines will be soloist for the morning service. The pastor will then speak on "It's a Terrible Experience."

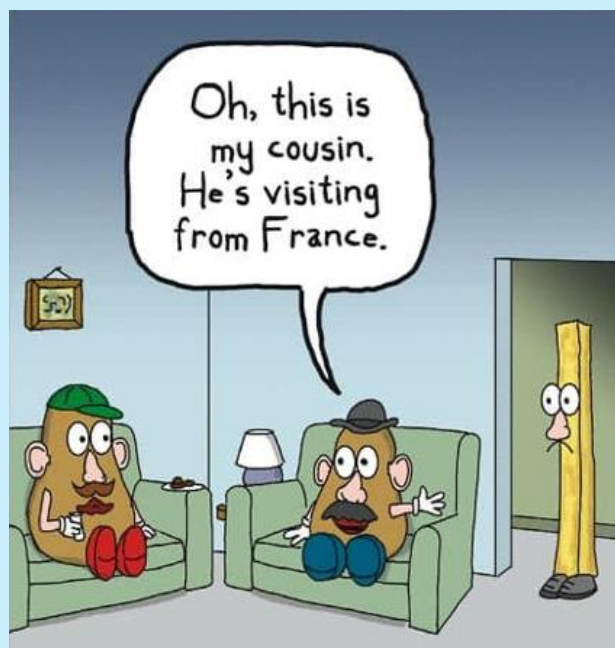




