




Volunteer Spotlight

Biblical Wisdom May, 2024 Mind, Body, and Spirit Connection by Linda Ridley, LUT

We have learned there is a difference between New Age, New Thought, and Ancient Wisdom within Unity teachings. Are we practicing New Age, New Thought, Ancient Wisdom, Biblical Wisdom, or a combination of all four? Let me know your thoughts and beliefs. This month I will share my research of Biblical Wisdom from the Hebrew and Christian Scriptures.


What is a good definition of Biblical Wisdom within Unity teachings? When Unity refers to Biblical Wisdom, we must remember that the Old Testament is referred to as the Hebrew Scriptures. Many other religions have their own old scriptures which have much Wisdom within them. Unity refers to the New Testament as the Christian Scriptures. There are currently over 3,030 versions of the Bible in over 2,011 languages available digitally. The three main different books are: a Jewish Bible, a Protestant Bible, and a Catholic Bible. Unity considers the New Revised Standard Version (NRSV) of the Scriptures as its primary spiritual resource for the teaching of Truth, especially the teachings of Jesus. Most versions can be downloaded in many languages now.

Wisdom from these Scriptures is difficult to trace as much of it came before written records were kept and passed down through generations by oral tradition, observation and experience, spiritual and philosophical inquiry, cultural exchange, and teachings. No originals of the Scriptures have survived as they were initially written and copied by hand on papyrus scrolls. The earliest known manuscript of the *Christian Scriptures* is the *Codex Sinaiticus* compiled in the 4th century CE. We must remember that both the *Hebrew and Christian Scriptures* have been written and re-written many times over the years reflecting humanity's cultural and linguistic diversity, as well as the beliefs of the translator at the time.

Many books within the *Hebrew and Christian Scriptures* have been left out of what we read today for various reasons. We know that Solomon was believed to have the greatest wisdom, yet the *Book of Solomon* is not in many Bibles today. In the *Book of Proverbs 9:1*, the seven pillars are taught still today as: "fear of the Lord, instruction, knowledge, understanding, discretion, counsel, and reproof." According to *Proverbs 9:10*, the four instructions to get Wisdom are: the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom; the second step is to desire wisdom; then pray for wisdom; and study the Scriptures again and again. The four classes of Wisdom, according to *James 3:15-17*, are: "earthly wisdom, Intellectual wisdom, devilish wisdom, and the wisdom from above."

I believe there is much Wisdom that can be gained when reading all Scriptures. Unity encourages readers of the Scriptures to study them as a historical document while metaphysically looking for the spiritual meaning underlying everything. The people, places, and events are representative of an idea or a state of consciousness. There is no one interpretation which can be considered universal or applicable in all cases. We interpret what we read according to our present understanding. There are many interpretations available to study which can be found at truthunity.net, including *The Metaphysical Bible* and *The Revealing Word*. Another source is the book by Frank Giudici, *How Unity Interprets the Bible*. For those who are ready to unlearn previous teachings, I also recommend the book by Marcus J Borg, *Reading the Bible Again for the First Time*. Check out our Unity East Lending Library for more books.

I believe studying history and the Scriptures can provide us with the ability to think historically and use the lessons of the past to make decisions in the present, and to plan. Ancient & Biblical Wisdom is important for modern living as it can provide us insight and practical answers to today's social, economic, political, and personal problems. Studying about the men and women of the Hebrew and Christian Scriptures can provide us with much wisdom we can use today at any age.





Lisa Beamer is the wife of Todd Beamer who said, 'Let's Roll!' and helped take down the plane that was heading for Washington, DC on 9/11. "It's the little things I miss about Todd - Hearing the garage door open as he came home and the children running to meet him." Lisa recalled: "I had a special teacher in high school whose husband died suddenly of a heart attack. A week after his death, she shared some insight with her students. With a gentle look of reflection on her face, she said, 'I would like to share a thought unrelated to class, which I feel is very important. Each of us is put here on earth to learn, share, love, appreciate and give of ourselves. We don't know when this fantastic experience will end. It can be taken away at any moment. Perhaps this is Heaven's way of telling us that we should make the most out of every single day.' Her eyes began to water. 'So I would like you all to promise me that from now on, on your way to school or on your way home, find something beautiful to notice. It can be something you see, a scent of freshly baked bread, the sound of the breeze rustling the trees, or the way the morning light catches a leaf as it falls to the ground. Please look for these things and cherish them. Although it may sound trite, these are the "stuff" of life - The little things we are put here on earth to enjoy ... The things we often take for granted.' The class was completely quiet. We picked up our books and filed out of the room silently. That afternoon, I noticed more things on my way home from school than I had that whole semester. Every so often, I think of that teacher and what an impression she made, and I try to appreciate all the things that we sometimes overlook." Take notice of something special you see today. Go barefoot. Walk the beach at sunset. Stop on the way home from work for a double dip ice cream cone. As we get older it is not the things we did that we often regret, but the things we didn't do.

Humans use much more than just 10% of their brains

The human brain is the most complex organ in the human body. Given how little we know about the spongy mass, the claim that humans use only 10% of their brains seems not only possible, but likely. The myth got a big boost in Dale Carnegie's bestselling 1936 selfhelp book, How to Win Friends and Influence People. In the preface, journalist Lowell Thomas misquoted James, claiming the psychologist said that "the average person develops only 10% of his latent mental ability." But according to modern brain imaging technologies, areas of the entire brain are, in fact, active most of the time, even if they're not active all at the same time.
